1. Public Law 37-42, Section 48

Mr. Camacho explained that this public law allows for an exemption to the ratio. The applicant must prove they invested \$5 million dollars or more, must employ up to 150 people and provide a community impact assessment. The Mayor of that jurisdiction must hold a meeting for community input and send the findings to the board. Once the exemption is used, the license is not transferrable.

2. Class 5 Off-Sale Beer Alcoholic Beverage Licenses

Mr. Camacho reported the compliance team is having issues with Class 5 Off-Sale Beer licenses. They are having to educate wholesalers that seltzers, RTDs, and soju do not fall under beer and wine. License wholesalers and retailers who are noncompliant can be found in violation, and it will be brought to the board's attention. Chair Fisher asked if the RTD will be confiscated or will we tell them to get the proper license. Mr. Camacho responded that some sellers cannot even be licensed due to the ratio.

1 **Section 46. Merit Bonus Payments Owed for Prior Fiscal Years.** In
2 discussions with the Department of Administration on the status of merit bonus
3 payments owed to government of Guam employees and retirees, it was stated that *I*
4 *Maga'hågan Guåhan* only recognizes and will only pay the amounts owed from
5 Fiscal Year 2017 to the present. With regard to merit bonuses owed prior to Fiscal
6 Year 2017, the DOA Director represented that those payments can only be
7 adjudicated if there was an appropriation made by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

8 In the effort to address the unpaid obligation, *I Liheslatura* has requested on
9 numerous occasions from the DOA Director information on the number of
10 employees and retirees affected and the amount needed to satisfy the obligation.
11 Despite the requests, DOA has never provided the information but has been
12 consistent in stating that “an appropriation is necessary to adjudicate the bonuses
13 owed prior to Fiscal Year 2017.”

14 Therefore, *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* shall utilize the Fiscal Year 2024 Executive
15 Branch appropriation to pay the merit bonuses owed to all active and retired
16 government of Guam employees for all years (Fiscal Year 2010 to the present)
17 before December 31, 2023. A summary report detailing the final number of
18 employees and retirees (by agency) compensated for each fiscal year and the
19 amounts paid for each fiscal year shall be provided to *I Liheslatura* by January 20,
20 2024.

21 **Section 47. Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)**
22 **Reimbursements Monthly Report.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, *I*
23 *Maga'hågan Guåhan* shall report monthly the applications to and reimbursements
24 from FEMA. All reimbursements from FEMA are subject to legislative
25 appropriation.

26 **Section 48. Number, Cancellation, and Issuance of Alcoholic Beverage**
27 **Control Board Licenses in Excess of Authorized Ratio: Application: Hearing.**

1 The number of premises for which an on-sale general license or an off-sale general
2 license is issued shall be limited to one (1) for each two hundred (200) or fraction
3 thereof, inhabitants of the municipality in which the premises are situated; provided,
4 however, that without regard to such population limitation, a nontransferable, on-
5 sale, general license may be issued for any hotel of not less than twenty (20) rooms,
6 or for any premises designed to provide restaurant facilities for the public in which
7 the investment in its buildings is not less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), or
8 an off-sale general license for any retail business in which the investment in the
9 building is not less than Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) which shall employ no
10 less than one hundred fifty (150) employees, which shall be non-transferrable; and
11 upon notification by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board of the population
12 limitation exemption, a copy of the notice shall be transmitted to the Mayor of the
13 affected municipality, and a public hearing shall be conducted by the municipality
14 in the affected district for the purpose of community input. To the maximum extent
15 possible, reports and position statements shall be provided by the municipality to the
16 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board within thirty (30) days of the public hearing. No
17 on-sale general license shall be issued in lieu of or upon the cancellation or surrender
18 of an on-sale beer and wine license, except in case of an increase in population as
19 provided hereafter.

20 (a) Community Impact Assessment. Any business seeking an
21 exemption shall conduct a community impact assessment, which shall
22 evaluate the potential effects of the business on the local community,
23 including, but not limited to, traffic, environment, employment, and social
24 aspects. The assessment shall be submitted as part of the application for the
25 exemption.

26 (b) Local Workforce Preference. Businesses applying for an
27 exemption under this Section shall make reasonable efforts to prioritize hiring

1 of the local workforce. The business shall also provide training and skill
2 development programs to residents to enhance their employability.

3 (c) Review and Reporting. Businesses granted exemptions under
4 this Section shall provide periodic reports to the appropriate oversight
5 authority. The reports shall include updates on their progress, impact on the
6 community, and compliance with regulations. The oversight authority shall
7 use this information to assess the effectiveness of the exemptions.

8 **Section 49. Pick-up and Disposal of Green Waste.** Notwithstanding
9 any other provision of law, for Fiscal Year 2024, the Recycling Revolving Fund may
10 be used for the pick-up and disposal of green waste.

11 **Section 50. Typhoon Mawar Expenses.** Section 1 of Public Law 37-17, as
12 amended by Public Law 37-21, is further *amended* to read:

13 “**Section 1. Emergency Expenses.** Notwithstanding any other
14 provision of law, and in addition to the authority granted in Title 5, Guam
15 Code Annotated, § 22402 and in Public Law 36-107, *I Maga'hågan Guåhan*
16 [the Governor] is authorized to transfer up to Fifty Million Dollars
17 (\$50,000,000) from the Rainy Day Fund for emergency response expenses in
18 response to Typhoon Mawar, including, but not limited to, expenses related
19 to safety and security; food, water, and sheltering; health and medical; energy;
20 communications; transportation; and hazardous materials. Specifically, *I*
21 *Maga'håga* is authorized to utilize this appropriation for supplemental funding
22 to farmers; any Fisherman’s Co-op recovery efforts; the purchase and
23 installation of power generators for Guam Department of Education (GDOE)
24 school facilities; and the establishment of shelters and temporary housing
25 subsidies. In addition to the reporting requirements under Section 2 of Public
26 Law 37-17, reports shall show a detailed list of items or services procured
27 under each category by agency for contracts, capital outlay, and miscellaneous

General Information

Population limitation exemption of a general off-sale alcoholic beverage license in an affected municipality is granted to certain entities that meet the criteria set forth in Public Law 37-42, Section 48. Guam public law requires that these entities obtain an exemption from the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board based on the requirements below.

Application Process: This application provides the population limitation exemption under which an entity may obtain a General Off-Sale Alcoholic Beverage License in an affected municipality. The information in the population limitation exemption includes:

- who qualifies;
- what is exempt; and
- how to establish qualification for the exemption.

Exemption Requirements

Who qualifies? An entity determined by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to be currently exempt from the authorized ratio pursuant to Public Law 37-42, Section 48.

What is exempt? An approved General Off-Sale Alcoholic Beverage License in an affected municipality.

How to Establish Qualification: Verify that the entity's investment in the building is not less than Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000), employs no less than one hundred fifty (150) employees and conducts a Community Impact Assessment. The entity's population limitation exemption status will be verified by a public hearing which will be conducted by the municipality in the affected district for the purpose of community input.

To establish qualification, provide:

- **Community Impact Assessment.** Any business seeking an exemption shall conduct a community impact assessment, which shall evaluate the potential effects of the business on the local community, including, but not limited to, traffic, environment, employment, and social aspects. The assessment shall be submitted as part of the application for the exemption.
- **Local Workforce Preference.** Businesses applying for an exemption under this Section shall make reasonable efforts to prioritize hiring of the local workforce. The business shall also provide training and skill development programs to residents to enhance their employability.
- **Review and Reporting.** Businesses granted exemptions shall provide periodic reports to the appropriate oversight authority. The reports shall include updates on their progress, impact on the community, and compliance with regulations. The oversight authority shall use this information to assess the effectiveness of the exemptions.

Documents Required

- 1. Application for Alcoholic Beverage License Population Limitation Exemption
- 2. Proof of building investment.
- 3. Proof of measured number of employees.
- 4. Community Impact Assessment.

The Department of Revenue and Taxation Compliance Branch will issue an *Alcoholic Beverage License* based on the approval of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to each entity that qualifies for an exemption.
