- Adoption of 2016 Guam State Epidemiological Profile Baseline Study pursuant to Title 11 G.C.A. § 8120:

- ❖ Chairperson Williams asks that sub committees include Adrian Cruz from the Governor's Office in all communications and extend invitation to committee meetings.


Open Discussions/Announcements
