Thanks for reaching out. I have included some information below for you. I would love to have a call with you to tell you more about CANNRA and show you some of the resources we have. Let me know if you have some time on Thursday, January 30 in the morning (your time). I am in Seattle, WA, so on PST.

Here is some information to get you started:

**Who is CANNRA?** As I am sure you know, CANNRA is a nonpartisan, nonprofit association of governments. We have no nongovernmental members. We do not take funding from industry or have industry members, though we work with a wide range of national and international stakeholders, including public health and safety partners, industry trade associations, researchers, policy experts, advocates, technology companies, lawyers, etc. We exist for educational purposes and our focus is on connecting governments to learn from each other and troubleshoot common challenges. Our members include more than 45 states and U.S. territories (including the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services), Canada, the Netherlands, Malta, and Albania.

**What Does it Cost to be a Member?** Membership costs \$2,875 per agency per year. We have statewide/territory wide memberships as well, but these usually only cost out if you plan to have 3+ agencies involved in CANNRA. Otherwise, each agency joins directly. Membership is with the agency, not the individual, and allows for participation from any direct agency employee (no contractors or consultants). If you decide to join, we will send you an "intent to join" form. Once we have the form signed, we invoice you and as soon as you have the invoice from us, you can start having staff engage with CANNRA. The invoice will be issued immediately. In subsequent years, you would fall into an invoicing schedule where you receive your dues invoice either January 1 or July 1.

**What does membership include?**

CANNRA Membership benefits include:

- Access to member regulators for government-to-government technical assistance;
- Access to institutional knowledge and expertise related to regulatory approaches for hemp-derived products, medical cannabis, and adult use cannabis;

- Opportunities to participate in CANNRA Special Committees spanning a range of topics relevant to cannabis regulation;
- Opportunities to attend webinars and other trainings and programming featuring subject matter experts;
- Access to cannabis policy tracking and analysis from member jurisdictions;
- Resources for cannabis policy development and staff training, and the ability to access and participate in best practice discussions across a range of areas, including but not limited to: packaging, labeling, advertising, testing, licensing, social and economic equity, compliance & enforcement, product approval, tax structures & collection, banking, patient qualification & enrollment, product manufacturing, and cannabinoid hemp products;
- Access to exchanges and forums between CANNRA members and third party stakeholders such as US and international regulatory agencies and elected officials, advocacy groups, academic institutions, research organizations, cannabis and hemp industry associations, and more.
- Access to attend our Annual CANNRA Member Meeting and the CANNRA External Stakeholder Meeting

We use *Basecamp* as a platform to organize resources and connect members. I can give you a demo of this when we jump on a call.

If you join CANNRA, you will be able to register for our June External Stakeholder meeting at a lower rate than what is publicly available. While we cannot fully cover registration to our meetings for members, we subsidize it to lower the rate over what is publicly available.

## **2025 CANNRA External Stakeholder Meeting: Denver, CO**

### **WHAT IS THE MEETING PURPOSE?**

The purpose of this meeting is to bring together a diverse array of national and international stakeholders in cannabis and cannabinoid policy, representing a range of perspectives and opinions, to engage in discussions with CANNRA member regulators and other attendees on cannabis and cannabinoid regulatory and policy topics. We purposefully seek to avoid an echo chamber and to engage groups that have differing viewpoints. Opinions and perspectives shared at this meeting are those of the individuals or organizations sharing them and do not represent an official position of CANNRA or CANNRA member jurisdictions.

### **WHAT DOES THE EVENT COVER?**

The event covers a range of policy and regulatory topics in cannabis, cannabinoids, and hemp, which may include: federal and international policy developments, science and research, data, product safety, public and consumer education, standards development and standardization across the industry, medical cannabis, compliance and enforcement, youth access, social and economic equity, the legacy and illicit market, and more.

### **WHO CAN ATTEND?**

This meeting seeks to convene nationally or internationally focused entity working on cannabis, cannabinoid, or hemp policy, policy implementation, or regulation. This includes organizations working on the following topics related to cannabis and hemp: consumer and product safety, research, standards, technology, policy, advocacy, social justice, equity, data, legal issues, public health, compliance, and clinical engagement.

Eligible attendees are restricted to those groups working at the national and/or international level. Due to capacity, no state-level trade associations, coalitions, or advocacy groups are eligible to attend. Direct cannabis licensees are not eligible to attend on behalf of their licensed company. Attendees are asked to self-certify that they are not attending as a representative of an entity manufacturing or distributing tobacco, alcohol, or pharmaceutical products. To maximize participation, and to avoid any one group having outsized participation, there is a limit on the number of attendees permitted to attend per eligible organization.

### **REGISTRATION**

Registration for this event is open.

Capacity for the event is limited due to space. Registration rates are based on a sliding scale and designed to cover the costs of the meeting. The meeting has no sponsorships or expo area. It is funded by CANNRA and registration fees.
