 - h.2. Change to read: Video cameras having a minimum clear resolution to allow for the monitoring of any persons and activities in any area

§11230 Transport of Cannabis

- c. Change to read: The designated transporter must remain with the product at all times that the motor vehicle contains cannabis, cannabis concentrate, cannabis-infused product or cannabis.
- d. Following 'the licensed cannabis establishment shall...', include verbiage: 'document the transport in the seed-to-sale or'.
- e. + f. Strike
- g. Strike line: Violation may result in revocation of Permit to Operate.
