#### **Approval of Minutes**

- o The minutes of the March 5, 2020 meeting were unanimously approved as distributed, subject to corrections.
  - Correction: Michele Santos is spelled with one 'L'.

#### **Old Business**

- o Economic Impact Study (EIS) Update
  - Mr. Fujikawa reports: Prior to the pandemic, the numbers were assumed based on regular operations, to include visitor arrivals of 1.6 million within the year. First year initial report estimates 81,000 total cannabis users, of that 15,000 local cannabis users, and new cannabis users at 31,000.
  - Direct Spending: \$11.5M-\$12M during the first year and stabilized year
  - Induced Impact: \$92.6M during the first year, \$133M stabilized year
    - Adjustments to the EIS: A cover page will be included with a disclaimer stating that the study was conducted 'Pre-COVID'.
      - Director Arriola makes a motion to accept the Economic Impact Study that has been commissioned and prepared by the Guam Visitor's Bureau, with a clear distinction that the study was made prior to the COVID pandemic. Director Cruz seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Review and discuss DRAFT Rules and Regulations Sections:

# Cannabis Cultivation Regulation, Department of Agriculture

- Correction: Duly, spelled with one 'L'.
- Capitalize 'Regulatory' and 'Agency'; substitute in Department of Agriculture as the agency.
- Second paragraph is the policy statement.
- Consolidate 'Company name and individual point of contact name' with 'Contact information including Guam mailing address, Guam telephone number and email'.
- Change 'Individual point of contact' to 'Responsible official'.
- · Change 'permit' to 'business license'.
- Add 'Bonafide Farmer' to 'certificate'.
- Replace 'Any alterations and/or changes must be submitted and approved by the CCB and regulatory agency' with 'No changes or alterations are permitted to the Bonafide farmer certificate, unless first approved by the Department of Agriculture.'
- Change 'Bonafide Certification' to 'Revocation of the Bonafide Farmer Certificate'.
- Replace 'Marijuana' with 'Cannabis'
- Move security requirements to the end also, list the types. Add either/or
- Duplicate §10213 Operation Standards for Cultivators, PL34-80
- Mirror fire requirements from Medical Marijuana Law
- Change added in bold: '(b) The following non-synthetic substances
  prohibited for use in cannabis production <u>including but not limited to</u>:'
- Under Penalties and Disbarment, include: Violations of this chapter may
  result in the revocation of your Bonafide farmer certificate. All applicable
  cannabis establishment licenses are also punishable. These provisions are
  not exclusive. Those violations may be subject to other fines or offenses as
  otherwise permitted by law.
