CLARIFICATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND TAXATION 2018 TAX AMNESTY PROGRAM

The Director of Revenue & Taxation has issued this release to clarify the last day of the application period and the tax periods allowed for the 2018 Tax Amnesty Program. Since May 28, 2018 is the Memorial Day holiday, the last day to submit an application for Amnesty will be the following day, Tuesday, May 29, 2018.

Income Taxes: With regard to the tax periods, all applicants under the Guam Territorial Income Tax (GTIT) can apply for **tax periods ending December 31, 2016 and prior years.** 2017 Individual and Corporate Income Tax Returns are not eligible for amnesty.

Other taxes: All taxes required under Title 11 of the Guam Code Annotated (GCA) for tax periods up to December 31, 2017 are eligible for the Amnesty Program.

Real Property Taxes under 11GCA Chapter 24 are an exception which remains unchanged covering tax year 2016 and prior.

This notice will serve as an addendum to the Program notice and any information distributed contrary to this clarification shall be void. The Department regrets any inconvenience this may have caused.
